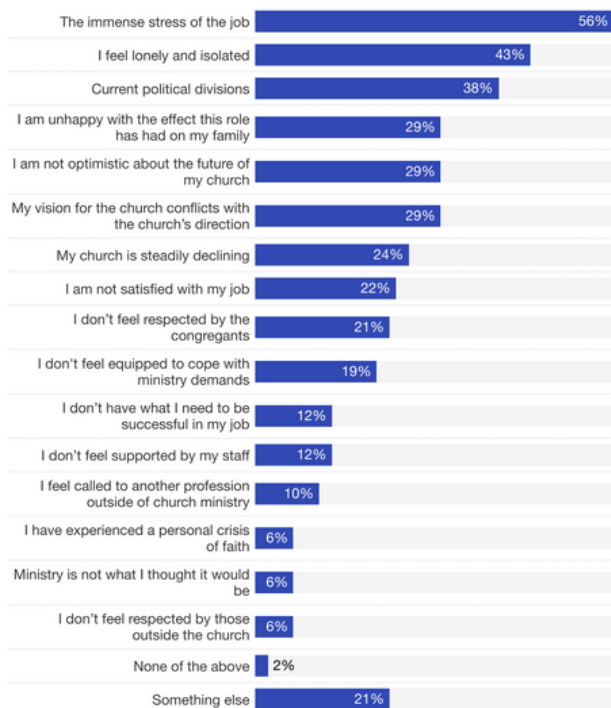
"As of March 2022, the percentage of pastors who have considered quitting full-time ministry within the past year sits at 42 percent" (Barna Group Research).
