### INTERNATIONAL MINISTRY PART 1

One of the most exciting aspects of our ministry is our international ministry. Our international ministry includes three elements:

- Pastor, Youth Pastor and Leader Training
- Resources, Support and Networking
- International Internships & Learning Experiences

Each month for the next three months we are going to highlight one of these elements of our international ministry. This month we feature our Pastor, Youth Pastor and Leader Training!

This program provides training to leaders in countries where poverty prevents them from receiving a formal education or quality training. These partnerships will be developed with organizations, denominations and church leaders in various countries in order to provide training opportunities.

**In Person Training:** onsite training led by our team around the world.

**Train the Trainers:** after 3-4 training trips, we train trainers to lead future trainings to maximize resources.

**Online Degree Programs:** we offer three degree programs in partnership with Kairos University (certificate, bachelors and masters). This provides high quality education and academic degrees to those who might not have access through simple sponsorships.

This year we hope to conduct a total of 5 training trips in Africa and South America and sponsor 5 students. Sponsorships for students are \$100 per month, per student.
